Caps on Fees for Credit Facilities Provided to Individuals

Following the industry consultation process on the subject matter, please find attached the final caps on processing fees for credit facilities provided to individuals which become effective from 1st June 2020.

Accordingly, licensees must not increase their interest/profit rates and annual percentage rate (APR) as a result of the above caps and that any adjustment to such rates must be based on changes to CBB policy rate. Licensees must also not introduce any other fees related to the processing, review or approval of credit applications.

Licensees are also reminded that any fees charged by third parties in relation to services such as insurance, valuations, governmental services, etc. may be borne by customers. In case of outsourcing of any services related to credit facilities applications, total fees to be paid by the borrower must not exceed the subject caps in the attached list.

Caps on Fees for Credit Facilities Provided to Individuals
