## Change to the Due date and Collection Process for the Payment of the Annual License Fee

As advised last December, for 2014 and the following years, the due date for the payment of the Central Bank of Bahrain ('CBB') annual license fee has now been changed to 1<sup>st</sup> December of the previous year for which the annual fee is due. As a result the 2014 annual license fee must be paid to the CBB by 1<sup>st</sup> December 2013.

In addition, all licensees will be required to pay the annual fees by direct debit and must complete the Direct Debit Authorisation Form attached and submit this form to the CBB by 15<sup>th</sup> September 2013 at the latest.

## **CBB Direct Debit Authorisation Form For Payment of Annual License Fees**

In accordance with the CBB Law and Rulebook, all CBB licensees are subject to an annual fee which must be remitted by way of direct debit by 1st December in the years prior to the years for which the annual fee is payable. The amount of the annual fee is prescribed by Resolution and is outlined in the applicable Volume of the Rulebook for each type of license issued.

All licensees must complete this form and sign the authorisation in order for the annual fees to be credited directly to the CBB account. No cheques are accepted by the CBB for the payment of the annual fees. The completed form must be sent by 15th September at the latest by e-mail to acsinfo@cbb.gov.bh
