

Purpose Code Logic

- 1) Check if field 77B is used and recognized in the database and contains /country code/
- 2) If not, check if field 70 (Remittance information) is used and recognized in the database and contains /countrycode/
- 3) If not, check if field 72 (Sender to receiver information) is used and recognized in the database and contains /countrycode/
- 4) If not, check if field 26T (Transaction type) is used and recognized in the database
- 5) If not, check if field 77B is used but not recognized in the database. If that is the case, display a customizable message to indicate that a wrong purpose code was used
- 6) If not, check if field 70 is used but not recognized in the database. If that is the case, display a customizable message to indicate that a wrong purpose code was used
- 7) If not, check if field 72 is used but not recognized in the database. If that is the case, display a customizable message to indicate that a wrong purpose code was used
- 8) If not, check if field 26T is used but not recognized in the database. If that is the case, display a customizable message to indicate that a wrong purpose code was used
- 9) If not, display a customizable message to indicate that no purpose code was found

Note: fields 77B, 70 and 72 are limited to three lines of 35 symbols. Field 26T is limited to 3 characters only.
