CBB Rulebook: Volume 2 – October 2022 Quarterly Update

The Central Bank of Bahrain (CBB) is issuing the October 2022 Quarterly CBB Rulebook Update. The latest quarterly update will be incorporated in the website version of the Rulebook under Volume 2.

The updated Modules for October 2022 are listed below:

Part A:

1. Authorisation Module (Module AU);
2. CBB Reporting Module (Module BR);
3. Capital Adequacy Module (Module CA);
4. Credit Risk Management Module (Module CM);
5. Enforcement Module (Module EN);
6. Licensing Requirements Module (Module LR);
7. Operational Risk Module (Module OM); and
8. Shari'a Governance Module (Module SG).

The details of the amendments are listed in the Module History Section of the above-mentioned updated Modules.

Banks must ensure that all relevant staff are informed of the latest amendments and that where needed, appropriate action is taken to ensure full compliance. Banks which are not in full compliance must notify the CBB.
